LESSONS FROM THE BIRTH OF JESUS

1. The Grace can and is able to locate you. (Luke 1:26-27)
 - God is not a respecter of persons and anyone can receive His grace. (Romans 9:15)
 - In Galilee, Mary was not the only virgin and Joseph was not the only man of the House of David.
2. God is able to send you people who can stand with you despite all. (Matthew 1:19-21) The problem with our generation is that we have too many people who are quick to detach, accuse and castigate and pretend they never met us.
 - You need people to take hold of your hand and say I believe in you. (Matthew 1:24-25)
 - If Joseph did not stand with Mary, she would have perished. (Deuteronomy 22:23-24)
 - Joseph went further as to ensure that that pregnancy is preserved. (Luke 2:6-7)

3. Where you are born doesn't determine your destiny.

- Don't use your background as an excuse for not accomplishing your destiny.
- What He is interested in is what He has deposited in you; when God has put His hands upon you, where you're born is irrelevant. (Luke 2:15, Matthew 2:9)

4. Jesus was the centre of Joseph's life.

- Joseph was never interested in taking the glory for himself.
- When we are serving, we sometimes forget that we are conduits/channels to God.
- As a child of God, we are instruments to God and all the glory should remain with God.
