- Demas was Paul's fellow labourer but he refused to change.
- Christianity is not emotional
- In salvation we are not spectators We must get from the stands and get into the pitch.
- The word is responsible for the change and transformation of a believer. (*2 Corinthians 5:17*)
- No amount of religious activities, or proximity to the pastor can replace the place of the word of God in the transformation of an individual.
- The Jesus in heaven is the word of God.
- The spirit of God did not change the world when it was formless. (*Genesis 1:1-3*)
- When God said Let there be light He released Jesus as the word and the world was Changed.
- The spirit of God minus the Word is not powerful.
- The more you have the word the more you are changed. (*John 1:14*)

1. The word of God pierces the heart. (*Acts 2:37 & Hebrews 4:12*)

3. The word is the breeding ground of faith (*James 1:22-23*)

 5. The word of God embodies the Holy spirit.
- When you have the word even the tongues you speak make sense.
 - The Holy Spirit becomes more tangible when you are full of the word. (*Acts 10:44; 1:2*)
6. The word of God is the salvation of men (*Acts 16:29-30*)
